



## Aqaba New Port – Package 3

### Prequalification's of Contractors for Onshore Facilities Construction Contract

Aqaba Development Corporation (ADC) is the central development corporation for the Aqaba Special Economic Zone (ASEZ). The New Port of Aqaba is one of Jordan's national infrastructure priorities and will constitute a major element of the country's long-term economic growth, as it is part of its sole maritime gateway and a key component of ASEZ's emerging positioning as a leading multi-modal logistical trade gateway for the Levant region on the Red Sea.

The New Port project has been divided into three packages, of which Package 1 (Marine Works) and Package 2 (Grain Terminal) have been successfully tendered and contracted. The project under this EOI, the Design and Construction of Package 3, the Onshore Facilities, comprises all facilities that are not part of the packages 1 and 2, and includes (but is not limited to) the Infrastructure, Yards, Buildings and Sheds.

ADC hereby requests technically and financially qualified local firms to submit an Expression of Interest ('EOI') for the construction of the Aqaba New Port Infrastructure, Yards, Buildings and Sheds. Interested parties wishing to be prequalified to tender for the project are requested to submit a fully completed EOI and prequalification questionnaire. Submissions are to be in hard copy and soft copy by email with the completed questionnaire being provided in Excel format. Information provided on the questionnaire will be used to select a list of contractors that will then be invited to tender for the project.

Companies that wish to be prequalified must demonstrate experience in the construction of similar projects with contract values in excess of 10 million JD. The contract will be tendered as a Turn Key project under FIDIC contract conditions ('Silver Book').

In order to prequalify, the local contractor should be qualified according to Government Tenders Department in Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan as a first grade in the specialization of buildings, electromechanical works and roads, or first grade contractor of Roads construction with a joint venture with first grade contractor of buildings and electromechanical works according to year 2012 registration. Details on the joint venture partners seeking to be prequalified, as well as evidence of the proposed joint venture, must be submitted with the prequalification submission.

Deadline to receive the EOI form together with the completed questionnaire, duly signed by an authorized representative, should reach ADC not later than October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2012, 14.00 Jordan Local Time. Submissions received after that date and time will not be considered. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

ADC will treat the completed EOI forms and questionnaire as confidential. Materials submitted to ADC will not be returned whether the interested party's application is successful or not.

This invitation for prequalification does not constitute an offer; nor is it a legally binding promise to tender the project. ADC reserves the right not to continue with the prequalification and/or the tendering process, to cancel the opportunity, or choose another approach to the development of the Onshore Facilities project.
